Why do we need to replace HVAC in the educational building? Is it broken? Why can it not be fixed?

The HVAC system in the educational building consists of 9 gas furnaces, 3 fan coil units, a gas boiler, & 12 outdoor condensing units, installed in 1996 (using older duct work) at a cost of \$250,000. It has served us well, though we have been resorting to frequent repairs over the past few years. These repairs have been increasing in frequency & expense. In the past 24 months alone, the cost of HVAC repairs has been \$20,000. Jim Freeman, who maintains the HVAC for our facilities, has notified us several times that the existing equipment could fail permanently at any time & require replacement on an emergency basis, which would be considerably more expensive than a planned replacement.
