



Return to In-Person Worship on July 5

The Session of First Presbyterian Church unanimously voted to follow the recommendation of our COVID-19 Task Force to resume in-person worship services starting July 5, 2020. An abbreviated service of morning prayer will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the sanctuary. Strong precautions will be maintained to protect the health of all attendees.

We will continue to improve the full, pre-recorded, online Service for the Lord's Day broadcast on YouTube and Facebook for the 50% of our congregation who expressed concerns about returning to worship and for everyone who is in one of the at-risk categories.

Anyone who wishes to attend in-person worship must adhere to the guidelines adopted by Session. Everyone who attends should first read the full text of the following documents:

Self-Screen!

Self-screen before coming to the church for any of the following signs or symptoms of possible COVID 19: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100 degrees Fahrenheit, known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID 19. If you have any of these symptoms or meet these criteria, please do not come to church for worship or any other reason for 14 days from the onset of symptoms and be fever free without medication (like Tylenol and Motrin) for at least 72 hours.

At Risk? Consider Online Worship!

If you find yourself in one of the at-risk categories (over the age of 65, pre-existing conditions such as obesity, BMI over 30, pregnant, heart disease, hypertension, lung disease, or otherwise immune-compromised), please consider continuing to worship with us online.



When you arrive!

- Remember your mask.
- Print the service outline if you want to have one available, or download it to your phone or tablet.
- Do not arrive early. Maintain social distance, 6 ft..
- **WEAR A MASK! (It is mandatory.)**
- Apply sanitizer.

- Only sit in a pew with a cushion; only share a pew with people in your own household.
- Limit restroom use.
- Did we already say it? Keep your mask on!
